
Secure Keypad Programming

Part Number(s): 20K0035, 20K0036

Problem: How to change the passcode on the secure keypad?

Solution: Follow this procedure to change the current passcode:

The keypad MUST be in its LOCKED state (awaiting a PIN) before starting this procedure. If the keypad is already unlocked, wait until it times out and requires the PIN number before proceeding!





- 1. Choose a new 4 digit pin code and record it below.
- 2. On the number keypad, press the **5** button for **5** seconds

 The **GREEN** light should blink slowly
- 3. Enter your **OLD** passcode OR **1234** if this is a brand-new keypad
 - The **GREEN** light should ON steady
- 4. Enter your NEW passcode from step 1 above.
 The GREEN light with blink 3-5 times and go out

Factory Default passcode is:

1234

This passcode is disabled after a new password has been set

What do the lights mean?

- Red Light Blinks once button on the user keypad was pressed
- Green Light Blinks Once button on the passcode keypad was pressed
- Green Light On (not blinking) No passcode set; must set immediately to avoid accidentally locking up keypad!
- Green Light Blinks Slowly Passcode entered and in secure mode; user keypad now active
- Green Light Blinks Fast Wrong passcode or user keypad pressed in non-secure mode

DO NOT FORGET the passcode!

Record the new passcode and store in a secure location.

NEW	Passcode:		

Forgotten passcodes cannot be retrieved and require a <u>new</u> security board to re-enable functionality of the security keypad!
